Passport Application guide for persons with One-US National Parent

APPLICANT EVIDENCE:

- Birth Certificate (*Official copy from your foreign place of birth. (Adoptees ineligible)*)
 - Optional supporting documents for Birth Certificate (*Baptism, Vaccination, First Census record, etc.*)
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- Two passport photos 2x2"
- Passport application at U.S. Post Office Pago Pago or other U.S. Passport agency.
- Passport fees. USPS Money Order or Personal Check only.

Adult Passport fee and Execution fee for age 16 and above \$165.00

Minor Passport fee and Execution fee for age 15 and below \$135.00

ONE U.S. NATIONAL PARENT'S EVIDENCE:

- Parent's Birth Certificate (*Search at ASG Vital Statistics for an official copy*)
- Parent's supporting documents (*Death Cert. , Non-US Parent's B.C., etc. Originals or official copies*)
- Parent's Marriage record (*Search ASG Vital Statistics or USA copy, or the foreign country*)
- Parent's other children born in Am. Samoa or USA (*Search B.C.'s of Applicant's brothers or sisters*)
- Parent's employment(s) record (*Search at ASG Dept. Human Resources or to local or USA workplace*)
- Parent's immigration record(s) (*Search at ASG Immigration Office or ASG Archives Passenger Lists*)
- Parent's hospital patient record(s) (*Search at ASG LBJ Tropical Med. Cntr. or USA hospital*)
- Parent's Am. Samoa Census. (*Search at ASG Archives for Census Certifications between 1900-1950*)
- Parent's U.S. Census record (*Search at U.S. Census on BC-600 form for yrs. between 1900-2000*)
- Parent's Blood Relative Affidavit(s) regarding residency (*Must be notarized*)
- Proof of parent's physical presence in American Samoa...

**Applicant must prove that his/her One U.S. National mother or father stayed in Am. Samoa, the United States or another U.S. Territory for 5 continuous school years from age 12-13 to 17-18. If not, then 7 years within any 10 year period after the parent reached the age of 14.*
